

## What is Amazon's Journey with Supported Internships?

- First pilot in 2021 in Manchester, with three supported internship starts
- 2<sup>nd</sup> phased pilot from Jan-June 2023 spread across Manchester and Daventry, with six supported internship starts
- WFCE saw the potential for the program and partnered with DfN Project SEARCH to follow their delivery model
- Since Sept 2023 the program has now had over 35 supported internship starts in Manchester, Swansea, Peterborough, Bristol, Daventry, Kent and Doncaster.

# How were relationships built to expand Amazon's supported internship program?

Best Practice:

- Partnership with DfN Project SEARCH
- Dedicated POC LA/College
- Site visits
- Attendance on steering group meetings
- LA buy in from the start of the partnership

## What do host business's need from Local Authorities?

- Support in launching the supported internship program and guidance to colleges
- Communication- between the host business, college's and LA's (for us steering group meetings have worked very well)
- Key next steps
- Key point of contact for the program
- Influence on the college back up
- Consistency across different sites- Delivery model (Amazon specific)
