If you have a learning disability, are neurodiverse, have a black or minority ethnic background or are part of our LGBTQ+ community, we would like you to think about applying.



You must be 18 years or older to be a Board Member.

We would like young people under the age of 35 to apply. You can be older.

You do not need previous experience of working on a board to apply.


The most important thing is that you share our aim to build a world where everyone matters.
