Dr Clenton Farquharson CBE, is a nationally recognised advisor, campaigner, and leader in co-production, equity, and inclusive health and social care. A disabled, neurodivergent Black man, Clenton grounds his work in lived & living experience and values-led action, influencing change from the front line to national policy.

Clenton is Associate Director at Think Local Act Personal (TLAP) and a key advisor to Ministers, contributing to the Time to Act Reform Board's work to improve and reform social care and health in England. He supports neighbourhood health system planning and is committed to advancing equity at every level. He also serves as a Peer Reviewer for the Local Government Association, supports the CQC's Well-Led leadership framework, and holds national roles with the NHS Assembly, Disability Rights UK, NDTi, and Skills for Care. Clenton was recognised with an MBE in 2014, a CBE in 2024, and is regularly listed among the most influential leaders in social care and disability in the UK.
