You will:

- ensure that NHS England and partner organisations prioritise the perspectives of people who draw on services, patients, carers, and family
- champion the diversity of public views
- be a critical friend, challenging NHS England
- share with others the work of the Sounding Board
- review and comment on documents and prepare for meetings
- act with integrity and respect confidentiality

Membership of the board will last until 30 April 2025 after which you will have the opportunity to reapply.

What is involved?

Being a member of the Older People's Sounding Board involves:

- Attending a short induction workshop to be held online on 7 February 2024, 11am-12.30pm.
- Attending 5 Sounding Board meetings between February 2024 and April 2025. Some will be held in person, others will be held online see the dates below. Each meeting will be up to 3 hours long. We expect members of the Sounding Board to commit to attending as many of the 5 meetings as possible.
- You will be expected to listen actively and share your thoughts in a constructive way.
- Further opportunities to get involved in regular Themed Conversations should you wish.
- Completing monitoring and evaluation forms.
